Dogs have always been in the family and relatives. First own was a wire-haired Fox Terrier, the second a smooth-haired. With the third, which became a wonderful mixed breed, an active dog life began at Bruks Hundklubben in 1965. Unfortunately, these were not allowed to compete at that time, so a Riesenschnauzer came into the house. In addition to being a working dog, he became a big winning show dog in the breed. A smaller variant, the Miniature Schnauzer came in 1970 and then breeding of both breeds.

Today it is a Wirehaired Dachshund as a companion dog.
