

Judge Presentation Benny Blidh von Schedvin

Benny began his dog journey at Katrineholm's Brukshundsklubb with a skilled mixed-breed female dog. At that time, mixed-breeds were not allowed to compete, so he acquired a Rottweiler.

Riesengårdens XO became very successful in the show rings in the late 60s, which led to breeding, and Benny also began breeding Miniature Schnauzers under the prefix Maximin, with great success.

Many champions have been bred, and Benny, who has a broad interest in dogs, has also owned and shown other breeds, including Beagle, Borzoi, Airedale Terrier, and Smooth Fox Terrier.

This year marks 40 years since Benny attended the judge's course, and he has judged in many different countries. We often see him judging in rings in Scandinavia, and since 2015, he has also been an all-round judge.

He has regularly judged Irish Glen of Imaal Terriers since 1993.
